Dear Parishioners and Friends,

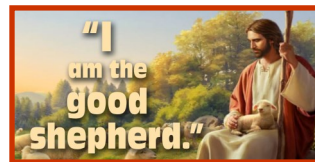

 Members of the Catholic Daughters will be in the St. John's Church entryway on Saturday, April 20, collecting donations for their Lifesavers Against Abuse Project.


